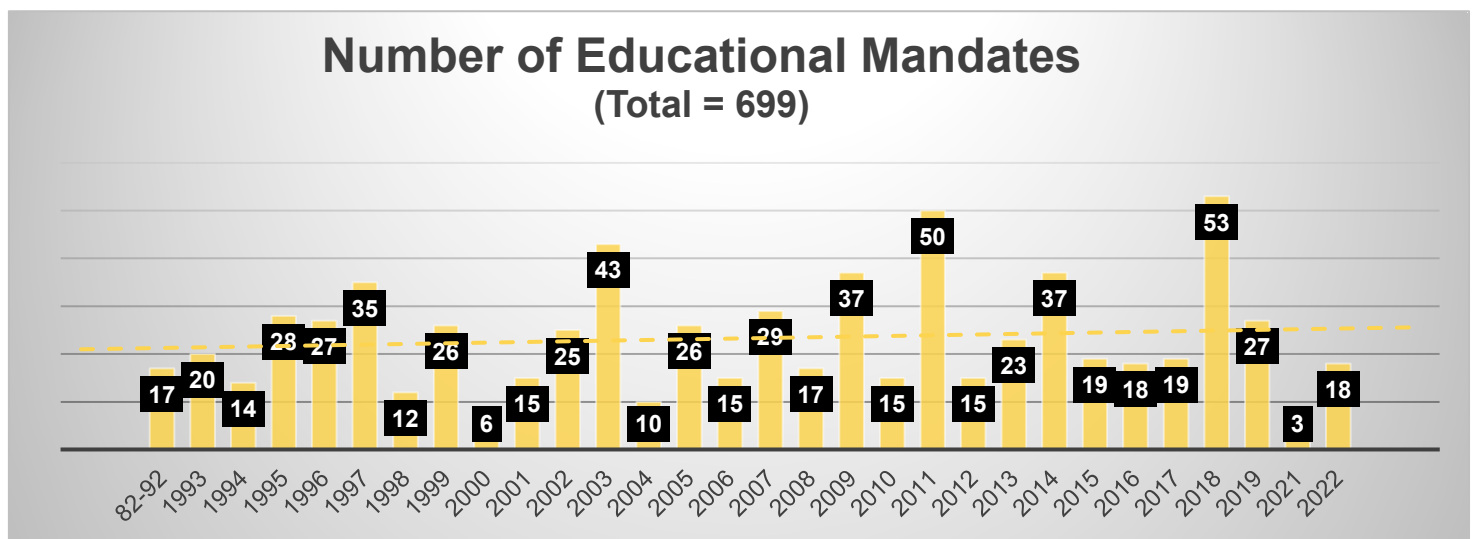


Educational Mandates

The State Mandates Act (30 ILCS 805/3(b)) defines a mandate as any action at the state level that would cause a local education agency to *incur additional costs* in carrying out that action.

How many educational mandates are there?

Pursuant to 105 ILCS 5/2-3.104, the State Board of Education must submit to the General Assembly each year a report listing all state mandates applicable to the common schools during the school year covered by the report, excluding only those mandates that relate to school elections. Since 1982, **699 educational mandates** have been legislated. The chart above shows the trend of enacting new educational mandates is continually on the rise.
