An Evening with Your Executive Director

In September 2000, **Michael D. Johnson** became just the fifth full-time executive director in the 98-year history of the Illinois Association of School Boards. He retired from that role in May 2007 but returned in July 2007 as executive director emeritus to focus on the transition to a new executive and to help with fundraising for the Association. He will relinquish that role and end 11-plus years of service with IASB in June 2012. Join us as we hear from Dr. Johnson talk about his 11 years with the Association.

Dr. Johnson will talk about his thoughts on his tenure at IASB. Where was IASB when he began here, where it is now, and where does he envision IASB going? What was his vision for IASB and how has he accomplished that vision? What were his greatest accomplishments and what legacy does he leave the Association? And how has his leadership helped IASB to become one of the most exemplary school board associations in the country with a stellar reputation?

Dr. Johnson will also be able to share with us some information about the new Executive Director who will be taking the helm on July 1, 2012. Come to this presentation to get the “scoop” on our newest employee!
