After a very eventful legislative session 2011, Illinois lawmakers will be returning to the Capitol this spring for a new session. School district consolidation, Regional Offices of Education, and pension reform are all issues which will be revisited as panels and task forces on these subjects are scheduled to make their reports. Follow up legislation to the Education Reform Act and the FY 2013 budget will also be on the agenda. **Ben Schwarm**, Associate Executive Director, Governmental Relations, IASB will give a full report of all the emerging legislative issues.
