Location & Size: Harrison School District #36 is a five square mile district located in northern Illinois in McHenry County, approximately 55 miles northwest of Chicago, with an enrollment of 500 students.

Curriculum: The district provides a comprehensive curriculum for grades Pre-K through 8. A Pre-K At Risk Program is available to further the developmental needs of three and four year old children. There is strong emphasis on reading, language arts, and math at all grade levels. The curriculum also includes social studies, science, computer literacy, art, music, and physical education. A special services curriculum offers additional help in the area of reading and learning disabilities.

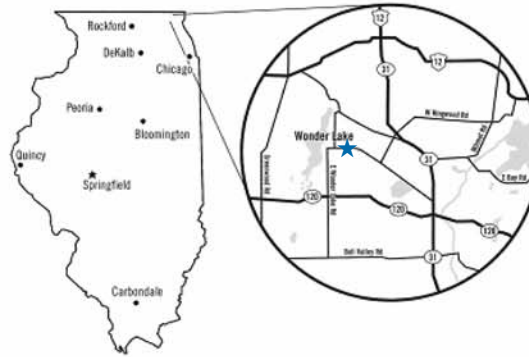

MEET OUR STAFF

Staff: 1 superintendent, 1 principal, 1 interim special education director, 1 social worker, 1 bookkeeper, 33 teachers (3 of which are part-time), 12 paraprofessionals, 6 support staff.

Facilities: The district is comprised of one attendance center. The school consists of a 1950's building with additions in 1955, 1959, 1970, and 1998. Major updates have been done in 2008 and 2009. A new building is anticipated when development of a new subdivision progresses.

Cafeteria Program: The district currently contracts Ceres Food for our lunch program.

Custodial: The district currently contracts with LaCosta for our custodial needs.

Transportation: The district currently contracts with Lakeside Transportation to operate four routes with two start/stop times.
