General Description:

The Board may not grant the student member any voting privileges, but shall consider the student member as an advisor. The student advisor may not participate in or attend any executive session of the Board.

A student representative shall be appointed annually to the position and may be removed from such position by a majority vote of the Board of Education. The student member shall serve for a term as determined by the Board.

- Attends any professional development opportunities as requested by the Board of Education
- Acts as a student advisor to the Board of Education
- The student advisor will meet with their respective building principal or designee prior to each Board of Education meeting to provide a student report.
- Principal will assist with the preparation of student report for the Board of Education.
