











Protecting America's Schools: A U.S. Secret Service Analysis of Targeted School Violence

Keeping children safe at school is a responsibility that belongs to everyone and at every level of public service. Illinois Attorney General Kwame Raoul is committed to bringing school safety resources to every Illinois community and invites you to a unique collaboration with the U.S. Secret Service and the Illinois School and Campus Safety Program.

The National Threat Assessment Center (NTAC) training will guide participants through *Enhancing School Safety Using a Threat Assessment Model*, the 8-step operational guide it developed from real scenarios.

NTAC presenters will highlight specific cases to provide relevant and realistic context. The training includes the key findings from the study, *Protecting America's Schools, A U.S. Secret Service Analysis of Targeted School Violence*. The report examined 41 school attacks that occurred between 2008-2017, in K-12 schools in the United States.

Learning objectives for the training include:

- Identify potential threats and individuals who may pose a risk of engaging in targeted attacks
- Demonstrate knowledge of the behavioral indicators, triggers, and situational factors of perpetrators of targeted violence
- Develop multidisciplinary and risk management strategies and interventions to mitigate the risk of harmful outcomes
- Introduce Safe 2 Help, a new Illinois platform to report school safety concerns or threats

This FREE, virtual event is for Education Administrators, Teachers, School Psychologists/Guidance Counselors, School Resource Officers (SROs), Law Enforcement, Fusion Center Analysts, Crisis Intervention Units, Counselors & Mental Health Specialists, Social Workers, or anyone potentially involved in risk detection/management. This is NOT active shooter response training.
