Grades 6-8 take PE/Health and Exploratory (Art, Spanish, and Technology). Grades 9-12 are offered PE/Health and electives such as FACS, Art, Spanish, Power Equipment, and Business. Grades 11-12 are also offered an opportunity to attend Lake County Tech Campus for career and technical courses. Band, chorus, sports, and numerous clubs are offered for students in grades 5-12.

A new ELA textbook program will be implemented for grades 6-8 in 2023-24. Curriculum alignment and development will be a focus for grade level teams throughout the 23-24 school year. Social studies and science in grades K-5 will be reviewed in 23-24.

Students have 1:1 access to chromebooks which allows for digital access to the curriculum and assessments.

The district is recognized as Targeted Assistance Title I where grant funds are utilized to support students in ELA and math through the MTSS process.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS — A comprehensive MTSS program provides reading and/or math intervention. The Office of Student Services oversees an ELL program that ensures academic support necessary to build language skills and pass the ACCESS test. Ringwood School Primary Center has a Preschool for All Program serving approximately 110 students with inclusive services for speech, social work and fine/gross motor skills. Social Workers, OTs, PTs and SLPs meet individual needs.

SPECIAL SERVICES — The Office of Student Services oversees special education services. Coordination among school psychologists, social workers, speech pathologists, occupational therapy assistants, teachers and paraprofessionals ensure student needs are met. Physical therapy and vision services are contracted services. This office coordinates services with other district departments to provide specialized services such as transportation or assistive technology.
