The Board of Education of Sherrard CUSD 200 Sherrard, Illinois is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Superintendent of Schools. The Board wishes to select a superintendent who will begin work on July 1, 2022.

It is anticipated that the total compensation package will be based on successful experience and education. It is expected that the initial contract will be for a multi-year period, as authorized by Illinois statutes.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE DISTRICT AND THE AREA

LOCATION — The Sherrard School district can be characterized as a rural bedroom community. Small housing developments can be found throughout the district.

TYPE — K-12; 1,400 Students.

OFFICE — 507 3rd Street, Sherrard, IL 61281.

STAFF — 5 Principals, 1 Assistant Principal, 109 Teachers, 100 Support Personnel.

CENTRAL OFFICE PERSONNEL — Unit Office Secretary, Business Manager, Assistant Business Manager, Superintendent.

CURRICULUM — The prek-5th grade classrooms operate under a traditional self-contained classroom model, and the 6th-12th grades use an 8-period model. The high school has programs that include business, FACS, vocational, industrial arts, and agriculture. The high school offers honors classes, Advanced Placement classes, and dual credit classes.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS — The district has implemented a one-to-one computer program since 2015. There is a gifted teacher for 2nd-6th grades. Band starts at 6th grade. Both elementary schools have art and music classes. The ag program has a greenhouse and farms approximately 80 acres of school property. **SPECIAL SERVICES** —There is a full-time nurse at each of the schools. There are two full-time counselors at the k-6 level. We have two full-time staff members at the JH/SH level designated to help students who are failing and need to recover credits. The district belongs to a special education coop (BHASED). The district hosts BHASED's deaf and hard of hearing program (DHH).

Winola Elementary

Located in Viola, houses an average enrollment of 281 students in grades PreK - 4th grade.

Sherrard Elementary

Located in Sherrard, houses an average enrollment of 238 students in grades K - 4th grade.

Matherville Intermediate Located in Matherville, houses an average enrollment of 211 students in 5th & 6th grades.

Sherrard Jr High & Sherrard Sr High

Located in rural Sherrard, house an average enrollment of 230 at the Jr High and 427 at the Sr High School.

All buildings are at ground level, they all have air conditioning, and they are well-maintained. The JH/SH has three gyms and a wrestling facility. The unit office is in the town of Sherrard and is separate from the schools. The bus garage is next to the unit office.

TRANSPORTATION — The district runs 12 routes. The start time and end time for the PreK-6th level and 7th-12th level is offset by an hour and 20 minutes so there are two routes in the morning and two routes in the afternoon. The buses are maintained and repaired by two full-time mechanics. There are three mini-buses, 3 staff cars and numerous maintenance vehicles.

FOOD SERVICES — The district employs a parttime food service director. The breakfast and lunch meals are prepared on site at each of the schools.

For major health needs, most individuals travel to the University of Iowa Hospitals in Iowa City.

CULTURAL — Each August, the city of New Windsor hosts a rodeo that draws fans and participants from miles away. Viola hosts a Christmas Walk each December. Sherrard has a Pumpkin Fest each Fall. Matherville hosts a large fireworks display each July.

RECREATION — There are several city parks throughout the district. New Kingdom Trailriders is a non-profit business that provides therapy for disabled individuals via horseback riding lessons and adventures. The Fyre Lake Golf Course just outside of the city of Sherrard was designed by the Jack Nicklaus organization. The city of Matherville has a small lake for fishing and swimming. The Fyre Lake housing development has several small lakes and a medium sized lake for the homeowners to enjoy.

PLACES OF WORSHIP — Methodist, Presbyterian, Lutheran, Baptist and Catholic churches are in the district.

COLLEGES — Numerous colleges are within a 40-mile radius of the district. They include: Augustana College, St. Ambrose University, Knox College, Carl Sandburg College, Blackhawk College, Scott County Community College, Monmouth College, Muscatine Community College and Western Illinois University.

INDUSTRY — A cardboard box factory is east of the city of Viola. There are two Agriculture Coops near the city of Viola.
