A robust academic curriculum is provided to meet the learning and social-emotional needs of all students. New phonics, ELA, and math programs have been/are being implemented. The district is committed to the PLC process and high levels of learning for all students. Teachers have identified the essential standards and implemented the common core shifts in all subjects. Grade-level teams meet weekly with a strong focus on using student data to plan and inform instruction. Daily time is provided for systematic interventions and enrichment. Assessment data are analyzed to determine the precise area of need for each student.

## **Special Programs**

To support the PLC process, the district has devoted teacher contractual time outside of the regular school day for collaborative teams to closely monitor and analyze student data to inform instruction and provide students with differentiated instruction. Each school's RTI team conducts progress monitoring for students who require additional interventions. The district offers the following K-8 programs: after-school academic programs and tutoring; summer school; after-school STEM program; STEM summer school program; and a two-year new teacher mentor program.

## **Special Services**

Approximately 14% of students receive special education services through an IEP. The district currently offers resource, self-contained, and co-teaching instructional services, as well as all related services when applicable. A number of public and private placements are utilized to serve students with low incidence disabilities and significant needs that cannot be accommodated within our district buildings.
